Being able to understand and articulate your impact intentions and then measure your actual impact is crucial, whether you're a social finance intermediary (SFI) managing a portfolio of investments or a social purpose organization (SPO) undertaking work that benefits people or the planet.

What gets measured gets managed

Strong impact measurement and management (IMM) practices improve impact overall and empowers datadriven decision making.

This in turn enables SFIs and SPOs to attract missionaligned investments with ultimately more capital flowing to impact.

The clarity that comes from developing robust IMM processes supports purpose-driven engagement between investors and investees, fostering a shared understanding of impact intentions and progress. This shared clarity not only strengthens partnerships but also enhances trust, paving the way for more transparent and meaningful impact reporting.

Through the Social Finance Fund (SFF), SFIs and SPOs can take advantage of several supports to develop and strengthen their impact measurement skills.

IMM Fundamentals is intended to help SFIs preparing for impact-focused due diligence with fund managers, including wholesalers in the SFF. Through videos, readings and other resources from experts on IMM, this self-directed online resource explores a range of IMM concepts and practices such as impact pathways, outcomes, investor contribution and impact ratings, and is reflective of the Canadian context and the IMM framework of the SFF.

IMM for the **Social Finance Fund**

IMM for the Social Finance Fund builds on IMM Fundamentals and aims to help SFIs refine their approach to IMM with hands-on support. Through this program, cohort participants explore and apply several themes. SFIs are supported to:

- Learn market-leading IMM approaches
- Explore how a flexible framework for collecting outcomes data supports IMM
- Leverage best practices in impact reporting to ensure transparency and accountability
- Incorporate impact considerations into financial decision making

This online, instructor-led program is specifically tailored to SFF SFIs. It is centered around interactive, hands-on, peer-to-peer learning and SFIs are supported to apply IMM frameworks to their specific contexts. This program, led by Impact Frontiers with support from Realize Capital Partners and Common Approach to Impact Measurement, runs twice a year, from March—June and from September—December.

One-on-One Coaching

SFIs enrolled in *IMM* for the Social Finance Fund can access coaching to dive deeper into program concepts and apply tools, resources and frameworks to their specific context.

Support for the Common Impact Data Standard and Common Framework

For SPOs and SFIs who have received investment from any SFF wholesaler

Adopting the Common Impact Data Standard is a requirement for each organization receiving funding from the SFF. Implementing the Common Impact Data Standard will make it easier for participants to measure and share the impact of their work throughout the SFF value chain. The Common Framework, which is not mandatory, will allow SFIs to aggregate diverse impact metrics they receive from their portfolio companies and provide rich insights into the total impact of their portfolio. Common Approach offers resources and one-on-one support and advice for SFIs and SPOs to implement these.
